FROM WARREN and ALL POINTS NORTH of BRISTOL

- Take **RT 195** to **Massachusetts Exit 2** to **RT 136 South (Metacom Avenue)**
- Follow into Bristol and follow until the 5th set of lights
- The Rhode Island Veterans Home is on the left-hand side of the road ~~past the 5th set of lights~~
 - **CHANGE** - Take a left at the 5th set of lights onto **Annawanscutt Drive** (at the light in front of the fire station) and then enter the property from Gate 2.

FROM PORTSMOUTH and ALL POINTS SOUTH of BRISTOL

- Follow **RT 24, RT 114** or **RT 136** to the **Mt. Hope Bridge**
- Go over the **Mt. Hope Bridge** into Bristol
- Follow **RT 136 North (Metacom Avenue)** through 3 sets of lights (*including the light just after the bridge*)
(Requires you to take a right at the fork in front of Roger Williams University)
- The Rhode Island Veterans Home is on the right-hand side of the road ~~past the 3rd set of lights~~
 - **CHANGE** - Take a right at the 4th set of lights onto **Annawanscutt Drive** (at the light in front of the fire station) and then enter the property from Gate 2.
