4. **Our first performance is this FRIDAY, JUNE 30th at the Seekonk Meadows (with a rain date of SATURDAY, JULY 1, 2017) adjacent to the Seekonk Public Library located at 410 Newman Avenue - Seekonk, MA 02771. If it is necessary to postpone, an announcement will be made via email, a post on our website's homepage, a post in the BAND App, and a post on our Facebook page by 3:00 p.m. on the day of the concert. If you are able to help unload the equipment trailer with us, please arrive for 4:15 p.m. otherwise the call-time for EBSYE is 5:00 p.m. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING A WIRE MUSIC STAND, SUNGLASSES, AND CLOTHES PINS TO EACH CONCERT ALONG WITH YOUR MUSIC AND INSTRUMENT!!! NO MUSIC STANDS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR NON-PERCUSSIONISTS.** Directions to the library are listed on the back of this announcement. **PARKING IS A PROBLEM! There are not many spaces at the library and once they are filled up, you are asked to park your vehicles at the Dr. Kevin M. Hurley Middle School just up the road at 650 Newman Avenue. I suggest dropping off students and their instruments at the Meadows / Library and older members of your party as the school is exactly 0.6 miles away and a 12-minute walk according to Google Maps. One of the stipulations to booking this event was our assurance that our members and families would not illegally park on Newman Avenue. Please plan accordingly!** Times are listed below**

5. Here is some of the information that you will need for each performance.
 - a. **Please arrive at the designated call-time for each performance (listed above) in order to set-up and warm-up. If it rains, check the web-site for postponement announcement that will be made up by 3:00 p.m. Those that are able to arrive at the unload times listed above to help unload the trailer, the help would be appreciated! ☺**
 - b. Please inform your parents that these are free concerts (except for the "Night at the Pops" which will have a small admission fee to help defray the cost of the performance venue) and many spectators bring lawn chairs to sit and enjoy the performance (once again, except for the "Night at the Pops" which will take place in the Performing Arts Center at SBRHS).
 - c. Directions to each concert will be located on the back of that week's announcement and on the web site.
 - d. **Concert Dress for Boys** is Black Pants, Black Socks, Black Shoes (NO SNEAKERS) and a White Collar/Button Shirt.
 - e. **Concert Dress for Girls** is Black Pants or Skirt, Black Dress Shoes (NO SNEAKERS) and a White Blouse.
 - f. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING A WIRE MUSIC STAND AND CLOTHESPINS TO ALL PERFORMANCES! There will NOT be music stands available for anyone at the venues other than percussionists and clothes pins are essential to avoid "run-away" music due to the wind!**

FROM TAUNTON

- **Route 44** to Seekonk.
- First set of lights turn right onto **Arcade Avenue**, turn right onto **Newman Avenue (RT 152)**
- Library is 1 mile on left.

FROM BOSTON

- **RT 95 South** to **Exit 2A**.
- At 3rd set of lights turn left onto **Central Avenue**.
- At **Central Ave./Newman Avenue** fork, turn right.
- Library is about 3 miles on right.

FROM PROVIDENCE

- **RT 195 East** to **Exit 6**.
- Turn right at the end of the exit ramp.
- Drive to the next traffic light and turn right onto **Broadway**.
- Follow **Broadway** to **Newman Avenue (RT 152)**
- Cross **Pawtucket Avenue (RT 114)**.
- Drive about 1.6 miles.
- The library is on your left.

FROM FALL RIVER

- **RT 195 West** to **Exit 1**.
- Turn right at the end of the exit ramp.
- At the Grist Mill Tavern stay straight (***with current construction, it's a slight right***) onto **Arcade Avenue**.
- Continue on **Arcade Avenue** to the end.
- Turn right onto **Newman Avenue (RT 152)**
- The library is one mile down the road on the left.
