Announcements

1. Welcome to week five! Only 2 more rehearsals before our first performance including this evening! Next Wednesday we will run through the concert order and load the trailer with all the equipment that we need for the performance.
2. Be sure at the end of each rehearsal to put both your music stand and chair back on the provided racks as the band room is used by others during the school day. As well, please sign-in to each rehearsal on the **sign-in sheet**.
3. **Flutes, Clarinets, and All those yet to have supplied a snack**, please bring a snack for next week's break. As always, I will provide the beverages. The band room has limited space so we will need to be sure to be neat and clean up after ourselves.
4. **Polo Shirts** and **Folios** have been ordered. The polos will be in by the rehearsal on June 20 in time for our 1st performance. I will either have them for that rehearsal or at the concert. If I have yet to receive them in time for that rehearsal, please wear a white shirt to the concert and we will have a "green room" to change in if I have them for that evening. I am just being a little proactive, but we should have them in time. The folios usually take a few weeks to a month to come in. I will keep you posted.
5. **BAND App**. We were very successful in using the BAND app to disseminate information quicker and more efficiently to you last year! Documents, calendars, weekly announcements, and up-to-date information will be available now in this one application rather than checking the website, email, Facebook, and paper documents. The BAND App is completely free to use! You can download the BAND App on our iPhone, Android device, or access it on your computer by going to **band.us**. I suggest that you set it up on a computer first and then download the app once you have an account established. 6. Our first performance will be at **Independence Park in Bristol, RI** for the **Bristol 4th of July Concert Series** on **Monday, June 25th from 6:30 p.m. - 7:30 p.m. (4:30 p.m. Report Time / 5:00 p.m. Sound Check)**. The Bristol 4th of July Concert Series is under the same management as the past few years and will once again have a full stage and sound system set-up at Independence Park. This is the reason that we contractually have to show up that early. As we have for the past seven years, we will be sharing billing with another group. Once again that other act is Michael DiMucci for whom I and some of our members have been contracted to perform with. It should be a great night of music! Please write your name on the conflict sheet if you are unable to attend any concert. **Please remember to bring a wire music stand and clothespins to each concert.**
7. **Section Leaders will be given the parts for each section when music is distributed.** (Section Leaders are designated, veteran members of the ensemble) It is at their discretion who receives what part, but they will be sure to be fair about allowing everyone a chance at 1st parts that wish and are able to play them. This will ensure that our instrumentation is well balanced! Please be patient with this process.
8. We are now selling **advertisement placards to be displayed on our equipment trailer**. Each advertising placard is 12"-18" wide x 24"-36" long in size with up to 4 colors and is displayed for 3 years on the trailer for an initial cost of \$300 (renewable for subsequent 3 year periods for \$225). 9. We will also be presenting the 12th annual **"Night at the Pops" Concert** on Friday, August 3, 2018 at Somerset Berkley Regional High School to close our season.
