1. Welcome to week six, our last rehearsal before our first performance! Tonight, we will run through the concert order and then load the trailer with all the equipment that we need for the performance. Since I will be performing following the EBSWE performance with Michael DiMucci, I will need everyone's help to reload the trailer immediately after our performance. We will not be traveling back to the school to unload. I will ask my SBRHS music students to unload on Tuesday evening before their marching band rehearsal.
2. Be sure at the end of each rehearsal to put both your music stand and chair back on the provided racks as the band room is used by others during the school day. As well, please sign-in to each rehearsal on the **sign-in sheet**.
3. **Saxophones, Bassoons, and French Horns**, please bring a snack for next week's break. As always, I will provide the beverages. The band room has limited space so we will need to be sure to be neat and clean up after ourselves.
4. **Polo Shirts** and **Folios** have not yet arrived as of Tuesday. If I have yet to receive them in time for tonight's rehearsal, please wear a white shirt to the concert and we will have a "green room" to change in when I have them for that evening. Our first performance will be at **Independence Park** in **Bristol, RI** for the **Bristol 4<sup>th</sup> of July Concert Series** on **Monday, June 25<sup>th</sup>** from **6:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. (4:30 p.m. Report Time / 5:00 p.m. Sound Check)**. The Bristol 4<sup>th</sup> of July Concert Series is under the same management as the past few years and will once again have a full stage and sound system set-up at Independence Park. This is the reason that we contractually have to show up that early. As we have for the past seven years, we will be sharing billing with another group. Once again that other act is Michael DiMucci for whom I and some of our members have been contracted to perform with. It should be a great night of music! Please write your name on the conflict sheet if you are unable to attend any concert. **Please remember to bring a wire music stand and clothespins to each concert. CONCERT DRESS is black dress bottoms (no jeans), black dress shoes (no sneakers), and your White EBSWE POLO. I highly recommend sunglasses as the potential of glaring sun is high.**
7. We will also be presenting the 12th annual "**Night at the Pops**" Concert on Friday, August 3, 2018 at Somerset Berkley Regional High School to close our season. **Independence Park – Thames Street – Bristol, RI 02809**

**FROM WARREN and ALL POINTS NORTH of BRISTOL**

- Take **RT 195** to **Massachusetts Exit 2** to **RT 136 South**
- Follow into Bristol and follow until the 5th set of lights
- Take a right at the 5th set of lights in Bristol onto **Chestnut Street**
- Follow until the end of the road and take a left onto **Hope Street (RT 114)**
- Follow for approx. 3/4 of a mile and take a right at the fork in the road onto Thames Street just after Sip 'n' Dip Donuts

**FROM PORTSMOUTH and ALL POINTS SOUTH of BRISTOL**

- Follow **RT 24, RT 114** or **RT 136** to the **Mt. Hope Bridge**
- Go over the **Mt. Hope Bridge** into Bristol
- Follow **RT 114 (Hope Street)** for approx. three miles into Bristol (*Requires you to take a left at the fork in front of Roger Williams University*)
- Just past Colt School, take a left onto Bradford Street and then a quick right onto Thames Street. The park is just ahead on the left-hand side of the road
