 - a. **Please arrive at the designated call-time for each performance (listed above) in order to set-up and warm-up. If it rains, check the web-site and/or BAND App for postponement announcement that will be made up by 3:00 p.m. Those that are able to arrive at the unload times listed above to help unload the trailer, the help would be appreciated! ☺**
 - b. Please inform your parents that these are free concerts (except for the "Night at the Pops" which will have a small admission fee to help defray the cost of the performance venue) and many spectators bring lawn chairs to sit and enjoy the performance (once again, except for the "Night at the Pops" which will take place in the Performing Arts Center at SBRHS).
 - c. Directions to each concert will be located on the back of next week's announcement and on the web site.
 - d. **Concert Dress for Boys** is Black Pants, Black Socks, Black Shoes (NO SNEAKERS) and a White Collar/Button Shirt.
 - e. **Concert Dress for Girls** is Black Pants or Skirt, Black Dress Shoes (NO SNEAKERS) and a White Blouse.
 - f. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING A WIRE MUSIC STAND AND CLOTHESPINS TO ALL PERFORMANCES! There will NOT be music stands available for anyone at the venues other than percussionists and clothes pins are essential to avoid "run-away" music due to the wind!**
 - g. **Sunglasses for outdoor concerts are not only allowed, they are encouraged!**
